We would like to inform you that the first issue of the journal Organizacija znanja (Organisation of Knowledge) in 2014 (volume 19) was published on our new and improved webpages.

Volume 19 brings along some changes related to the form and time interval of contents being published in the journal Organizacija znanja. As of 2014, the journal OZ will only be published twice a year and exclusively in electronic form. The latest issue with new and improved web design has brought some improvements and new features: you can now read the journal on your mobile device, browse through it like you would in the printed copy, enlarge pages, use the interactive table of contents, print it in part or fully or save it to your device in pdf format, add bookmarks, search through the full text, share articles on social media and much more.

The archives of all past issues of the journal OZ will also be redesigned in due time, but in the meantime, our new web pages already contain the links to all the issues of both its predecessor COBISS obvestila (1996–2001) and the journal OZ itself (2002–2013) in their original online form.

On the new webpages, you will also find new instructions for authors, including a template in Microsoft Word which should help authors when preparing their articles (both in terms of form and content) for publication in the journal OZ.

In June 2014, the journal OZ was included in the full-text databases ProQuest Research Library and ProQuest Central. The editorial board will continue with their efforts to make sure that the journal will be indexed by as many international databases and data collections as possible.

We hope that our current readers will welcome the new features and improvements, and also look forward to attracting some new readers.

Allow us to also take this opportunity to invite you participate in the creation of future issues and we sincerely hope you will enjoy reading our journal.
